

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-19

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORONADO, CALIFORNIA, DESIGNATING LOCAL AGENCY OFFICIALS REQUIRED TO RECEIVE FISCAL AND FINANCIAL TRAINING PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 53237 ET SEQ.

WHEREAS, the integrity of local government relies upon the sound stewardship of public funds and the transparent management of city resources; and

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 53237 et seq. (SB 827) establishes mandatory fiscal and financial training requirements to ensure that those who manage, influence, or oversee public resources possess a foundational understanding of internal financial controls, public audit standards, and fiduciary responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, state law mandates that members of a local agency legislative body who receive compensation, stipends, or expense reimbursements must complete at least two hours of fiscal and financial training every two years; and

WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes that fiscal oversight is a shared responsibility across several tiers of city governance, and therefore finds it necessary to extend these training requirements to the following groups of local agency officials:

1. **Elected Officers:** Members of the City Council who exercise ultimate authority over the city budget and financial policy.
2. **Appointed Officials:** Members of city boards, commissions, and committees who make fiscal, budgeting, or public resource use recommendations as part of their official duties.
3. **Executive and Administrative Officers:** High-level personnel responsible for the daily administration of city funds and the implementation of internal controls.
4. **Designated Employees:** Specific staff members identified by the City Council who manage departmental budgets, handle city revenue, or process financial transactions that impact the city's fiscal health; and

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 53237.1(b) grants the City Council the authority to designate specific employees to undergo this fiscal and financial training to ensure comprehensive fiscal accountability throughout the organization.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Coronado as follows:

SECTION 1: Mandatory Training for Legislative Bodies. Pursuant to Government Code § 53237.1(a), the following positions are identified as local agency officials required to receive fiscal and financial training:

SECTION 3: Compliance, Tracking, and Recordkeeping. Every local agency official and designated employee identified in Sections 1 and 2 shall provide a copy of their certificate of completion of the fiscal and financial training to the City Clerk's Department. The City Clerk shall maintain these public records for at least five years. Pursuant to City Council policy adopted November 19, 2024, any board, commission, or committee member who fails to complete the required training within 30 days of the applicable deadline shall be disqualified from participating in meetings until the requirement is fulfilled. If the training requirement remains incomplete 60 days after the deadline, the member's seat shall be automatically vacated.

SECTION 4: Adoption and Biennial Review. This list is formally adopted as the "Fiscal and Financial Training Compliance Roster" for the 2026-2028 biennial cycle. This resolution shall be reviewed every two years in tandem with the biennial review of the City's Conflict of Interest Ordinance.

SECTION 5: Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this resolution. The City Council of the city of Coronado hereby declares that it would have adopted this resolution and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion thereof irrespective of the fact that any one more section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion may be declared invalid or unconstitutional.
