

## Downtown Beautification Project Furnishing Elements

### 1. Benches

- Recommendation: Include a circular cutout for a City of Coronado Logo medallion or donor medallion in the center of the back support on all new benches.
- Rationale: Existing benches in the downtown area include donated benches with rectangular cutouts for plaques, Coronado Rotary Club benches with circular cutouts for medallions, and benches with no cutouts. Standardizing the City's benches with a circular cutout will allow for a City of Coronado Logo or donor medallions.

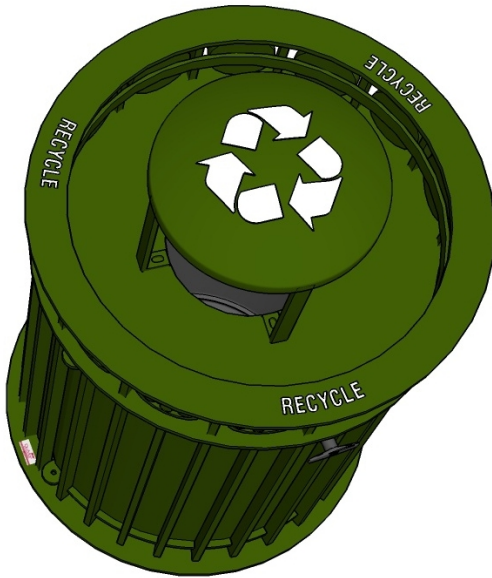


### 2. Recycling Receptacles

- Recommendation: Include “Think Before You Throw” signage on front and vinyl logos on domed bonnet and rim to designate recycling receptacle.
- Rationale: Vinyl logos are white for high contrast, consist of the chasing arrows recycling symbol on the bonnet dome, and “RECYCLING” three times around the perimeter of the receptacle’s rim. The vinyl is durable, intended for exterior use, and can easily be replaced in the field by Staff, if required. Including “Think Before You Throw” signage allows the City to detail which items are appropriate for recycling and further differentiates the recycling and trash receptacles. **Signage text and graphics will be presented to Council for approval.**

### 3. Supplemental Trash and Recycling Receptacles

- Recommendation: Purchase approximately thirty 45-gallon dome-top receptacles, stamped with the City of Coronado logo on two sides to be used during increased waste disposal in the downtown area.
- Rationale: Additional trash and recycling receptacles are required in the downtown area from Memorial Day through Labor Day. Currently, EDCO provides 35-gallon rolling carts to accommodate the City's increased waste volume. The rolling carts are not aligned with the aesthetic of the Downtown Beautification furnishings. Staff is currently confirming EDCO will pick up the City's supplemental receptacles in September, stored them at an EDCO facility, and redeployed them each May. If Staff is unable to reach this agreement with EDCO, additional options will be provided to Council for further direction.

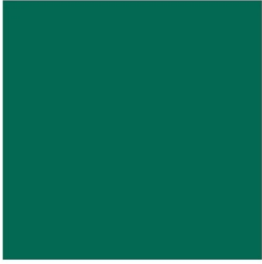
**Supplemental Receptacles \$610.00 each**



**4. Furnishing Color**

- Recommendation: The color selection for the wrought iron sides of benches, trash receptacles, and recycling receptacles will be RAL 6028, Pine Green rather than the previously selected Juniper Green. The six news racks in the Downtown Beautification project scope will be painted to match RAL 6028, Pine Green.
- Rationale: Juniper Green is a standard color provide by the furnishing manufacturer. Additional RAL colors are also available from the manufacturer and do not increase lead time or cost. RAL 6028, Pine Green maintains the rich tone of Juniper Green but is closer in hue to “Coronado Green”.
