CITY COUNCIL STAFF REPORT

Consideration of a Resolution Opposing Offshore Oil and Gas Leasing Off the California Coast and the Inclusion of California Outer Continental Shelf Planning Areas in the 11th National Outer Continental Shelf Oil and Gas Leasing Program

RECOMMENDATION

Adopt, modify, or take no action on the proposed resolution opposing offshore oil and gas leasing off the California Coast.

BACKGROUND

This item was placed on the agenda pursuant to City Council Policy #2, which allows any Councilmember or the Mayor to request that an item be placed on a future City Council agenda for discussion and possible action. The item was approved to be placed at a future agenda at the April 7, 2026, City Council meeting.

ANALYSIS
