WHEREAS, libraries, librarians, library workers and supporters across America and Coronado are celebrating National Library Week.


NOW THEREFORE, on behalf of the City Council of the City of Coronado, I do hereby recognize and proclaim April 19-25, 2026, as:

"NATIONAL LIBRARY WEEK"


